CONCEPT OF THE DEAD AND AGGRIEVEDIN NEWS GATHERING AND REPORTING

- Dead is the organism lost his/her life and cannot perform any activity such as breath Out there we consider human being as they have to be respected when they die.
- Journalist and news reporter must consider ethical issues when searching, gathering and reporting news about the dead, they must consider name of the dead, title, age, day, time of the death, name of dependents and also journalist must handle dead bodies with special attention.
- Aggrieved is the person who is troubled or harmed by something like war accidents, illness and etc. Journalist and news reporter must handle aggrieved with special attention and sensibility of those found themselves in difficult situation when they need help.
- In covering stories and event like this journalist must know what is story and what not a story is.

ETHICAL DO'S AND DON'TS IN PICTURE TAKING OF THE DEAD AND AGGRIEVED

- Have a sense of kindness and human when reporting stories about the dead. Show that you have been touched.
- Give them a hand of help as possible.
- Show sense of compassion to aggrieved
- Asking the permission
- Accuracy in writing the captions
- Capture a true images
- Respect the privacy of the dead and aggrieved.

ETHICAL DO'S AND DONT'S IN RESPECTING THE DEAD AND THE AGGRIEVED

Interview or ask question to a person who is in severe pain; don't force him/her to talk

Truth Focus on facts/Logic you have to gather the facts stories

Accuracy the story which have been gathered must be accurate the whole 5w's +H is there to your stories.

Respect the privacy/confidentiality of the dead and aggrieved

Honest

Balance and Fairness

Accountability

DECENCY AND INDECENT

Indecency media it is all about material and language which considered as offensive but still contain reference to sex or excretion of obscene, indecent and perform language in TV or radio program about murder, sex life are not good especially for children **while** Decency media is the tools, instrument, channels that are followed media ethics

ENCOURAGING DECENT JOURNALISM

Out of sheer 'greed', that is, the desire to attract more and more readers, viewers and ligteners, journalists usually fall into temptation and write in a manner that disregards the feelings or devious means to gather news.

ETHICAL DON'TS IN TAKING A PICTURE OF THE DEAD AND THE AGGRIEVED Avoid close up shot of the dead in funeral ceremony.

- Don't take a photo of a person who is crying uncontrolled.
- Avoid to show conflict of interest during capturing of the images.
- Avoid manipulation of the photos.
- Don't pay a sources for the picture taking unless for the public interest.
- Avoid plagiarism of the images.
- Encouraging decent journalism the kind of journalism that gives confidence to reporters to write stories virtuously- would help solve this problem.
- The language used in news reporting should not be disparaging and thus likely to annoy people;
- News on marginalized groups must be written using respectful language;
- Decent journalism requires that reporters and editors allow the party targeted by accusations to give its side of the story, at least for the sake of balance and fairness. The opportunity is known as the right of reply.

FEATURE OF INDECENT MEDIA

- Indecent material contains sexual and excretory that does not rise to the level of obscenity.
- The material must depict sexual conduct.
- Publish untrue information
- Discriminate the society
- Interfered in privacy and confidential material without fear.
- Plagiarism is allowed

EXAMPLE OF INDECENT IN MEDIA

- Use of body words or nudity picture
- Fleeting meaning uses of television commonly used expletives and naked human bodies or part of the bodies to dramatize a family setting.
- Crush video defecting actual give for purpose of sexual filiations.

ETHICAL DO'S IN DECENCY OF IMAGES

- Ask permission before entering forbidden or restricted places. If you want to take picture example: Military place, bank.
- Ask permission to take photo of patient who is under care if someone is had affected.
- Accuracy
- Cover some sensitive parts of the body
- Respect the individual privacy and confidential Areas.

ETHICAL DON'T IN DECENCY OF IMAGES

- Avoid close up dead bodies again Don't take picture that will reveal the identity of the complainant is any sexual assault
- Don't take picture if person crying uncontrolled.
